## POLICY:

Cumberland Heights' nursing staff recognizes that the intoxicated or otherwise disoriented patient may be unable to protect him/herself from injury and takes measures to provide this protection.

## **PROCEDURE:**

- 1. The patient is assisted to bed and side rails are raised.
- 2. The patient is instructed repeatedly not to get up without assistance.
- 3. If indicated; fall risk initiated and may include using an electronic bed monitor.
- Staff uses therapeutic communication skills to reassure and calm patient.
  Frequent checks continue until patient is no longer intoxicated or disoriented.
- 5. Cigarettes, lighters, and matches are kept at nursing station until patient becomes oriented.
- 6. All of the above information is documented in the patient's record along with any other pertinent data.
