POLICY:

Patients are assessed by a licensed nurse prior to release from the detoxification level of care to a rehabilitation level of care and/or discharge.

PROCEDURE:

- An assessment is completed and entered into the patient's Electronic Medical Record (EMR) at the time of the patient's transfer to rehabilitation level of care. . The assessment includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - A. Vitals signs and Level of Consciousness
 - B. Current physical complaints
 - C. Signs and symptoms of withdrawal
 - D. Emotional Status
 - E. Ability to perform Activities of Daily Living
 - F. Level of participation in therapeutic programming
 - G. Status of detoxification medication protocols, as applicable
- 2. If the patient is stable, the Medical Technician is informed of the patients that are to be transferred.
- 3. The bed change is entered into the patient's electronic record.
