Job Description: The Family Counselor provides psycho-education and structured group and individual counseling and/or therapy to patients and/or families impacted by substance abuse disorders. Primary duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Facilitates individual and group and/or therapy sessions, within the scope of practice defines by licensure and clinical privileges, including case management
- Conducts biopsychosocials through 1:1 interviewing, assesses clinical problems, and develops treatment plans and continuing care plans in conjunction with the patient
- Orients new patients to the program and schedules.
- Documents clinical activities in electronic patient record according to established policies and procedures
- Communicates and documents collateral contacts, including family members, EAPs, physicians, referral sources, judges, probation officers, etc.
- · Participates in staff meetings and treatment plan reviews
- Performs CPR and First Aid as needed
- Attends required in-service training and education
- Maintains confidentiality of company and personal information

Qualifications for Position:

- Master's Degree in Counseling or LADAC, LPC-MHSP, LMFT, LCSW or equivalent preferred or working towards licensure
- Three (3) years experience involving addictions related treatment with minimum of one (1) year experience involving age/population specific addiction treatment required.
- Experience with case management, counseling and continuing care planning
- Understanding of 12 Step programs and philosophy
- Excellent organizational skills for managing and prioritizing multiple tasks and assignments
- Excellent interpersonal, active listening and interviewing skills
- · Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Ability to maintain a therapeutic environment using a variety of behavior management skills
- Ability to deescalate a person in crises in calm and supportive manner
- Ability to use Microsoft Office products, including Word and Outlook and ability to learn clinical software

- Must have ability to work cohesively and communicate effectively as a team member
- If recovering, two (2) yeas of verifiable abstinence required with five (5) years of verifiable abstinence preferred; active participation in appropriate 12 Step program preferred
